Shepherd’s Hut and Beudy Bach quiet space

Booking Form

The accommodation consists of the Shepherd’s Hut (where there is a single bed, bedside table, desk and two chairs) and Beudy Bach (this being a small stone building next to the Shepherd’s Hut furnished with a sofa, table and chair, fridge, sink (cold water only), kettle, toaster, microwave oven and crockery). There are outside toilet facilities with hot water in between the above. All three spaces have electric heaters. Please be aware smoking is not permitted in any part of the site and accommodation is offered on a self-catering basis. At the Centre there are additional kitchen facilities and a shower.

These facilities are provided on a donation basis, to be paid securely by bank transfer (to St Melangell Shrine Church and Centre, sort code: 403532, account no: 31394185) or in person. Please note, **no card facilities are available**. Running costs are estimated to be £45 per day and contributions to the bursary fund are gladly received. A deposit of £20 is required to secure your booking. If you have financial difficulties, please contact us as bursaries are sometimes available to help with the cost of your accommodation. Please note that pets are not permitted. Please bring your own bedding and any food or drink needed for your stay (the nearest small shop is approx. 5 miles away and has very limited supplies). We can provide bedding if required. Although the water supply in Pennant Melangell is not mains fed it is treated by UV light and a filter. We ask for the accommodation to be left in the same clean and tidy condition in which you found it. Hand sanitiser and cleaning products will be provided, please ensure you regularly use them during your stay.
